## DESIGN MEETS CRAFTSMANSHIP AT MIDA 89

Florence, April 28<sup>th</sup> 2025. At MIDA 89, traditional craftsmanship meets design to offer a contemporary creative perspective that transcends the divide between the two worlds. A key example of this synergy is the exhibition "Galleria dell'Artigianato. The Essence of Making", promoted by Artex in collaboration with Firenze Fiera and set along the evocative Medici walls of the Cavaniglia Pavilion. On display are 24 works by Tuscan master artisans celebrating creative craftsmanship through a fusion of tradition and innovative technical and expressive experimentation.

In the Sala della Volta, the exhibition "Con.te.ne.re – From Object to Body. Variations in Scale in Craftsmanship and Design", promoted by CR Firenze Foundation, produced by OMA (Observatory of Arts and Crafts) and curated by ADI (Association for Industrial Design), Tuscany Delegation, focuses on the theme of "containment," both physical and metaphorical. The exhibition explores the functional and symbolic dimensions of containment through Italian craftsmanship and design, featuring the use of innovative, multifunctional and sustainable materials.

Among the many highlights of this edition is the rich daily program of **OFFICINE ESPERIENZIALI**, organized by Artex, CNA Firenze, Confartigianato Firenze, LAO and MUS.E Foundation, in collaboration with Firenze Fiera. Visitors can enjoy live workshops with master artisans, guided tours through the most captivating and hidden spaces of the Medici fortress and cooking shows — all free to attend with reservation (https://mostrartigianato.it/programma-officine-esperienziali/).

Tomorrow, April 29<sup>th</sup>, at **10:30** in the Spadolini Pavilion (attic floor) in the Taste Area, the **Cooking Show** will open with students from Florence's A. Saffi Hospitality Institute and Michelin Green Star chef **Stefano Pinciaroli** of Ristorante PS (Cerreto Guidi). In the afternoon, visitors can enjoy tastings and a hands-on demonstration of traditional potato tortelli with **Giancarlo Carnevali** from Forno Carnevali.
